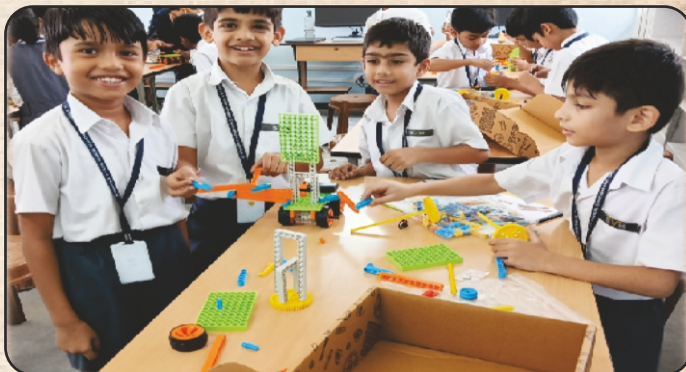

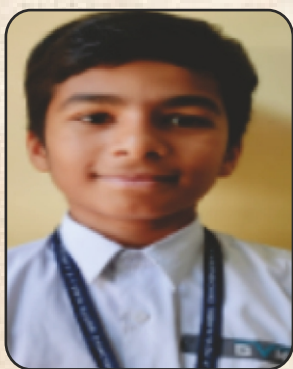


## AXIS'24 - JUNIOR SCIENTIST

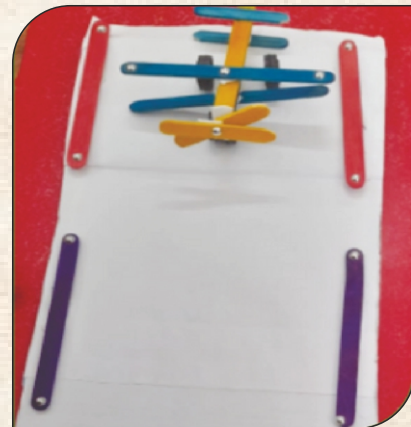

### Nutrition Week



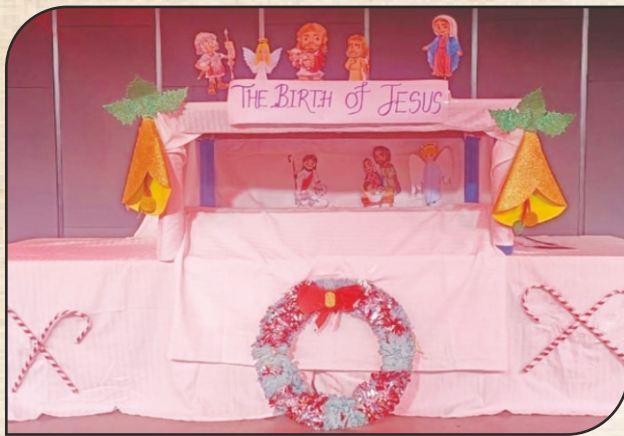
